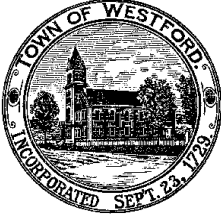

Whatever you bring onto the property you take it with you when you leave. We appreciate your help in keeping our parks clean and litter free.

I understand the permit allows my group access to the beach area and an assigned picnic area. The public is not excluded from use of the beach or adjacent areas not assigned to my group.

BEACHES FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY
PLEASE FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES FOR THE OPEN SWIMMING PROGRAM
Beach hours: JUNE 17 - AUGUST 26, 2018

Monday – Friday 8:30am – 5:30pm; Saturday & Sunday 10am-5pm
Concession Hours: June 23-August 26, 2018
Hours Monday-Friday: 10:30am-5:30pm

- **Fees:** *No charge for Westford residents – must show proof of residency* [see beach use permit application for groups of 10 or more]
- *\$5/person for non-residents; or season pass for 2 adults & 3 children for \$75*
- *Children under 3 and adults 65+, no charge*
- *Never swim alone - use “buddy system”*
- Don't dive head first, protect your neck
- *Children need adult supervision*
- Young children should be watched at all times
- Be aware - swim with care - this is only a partial list of safety precautions
- Report any dangerous situations to the Concession Staff or call the Recreation Department 978.692.5532 Or 978-799-9259
- *Leave the beach area at the first sign of lightning or thunder*
- All swimmers must stay within the designated swim area
- **No animals allowed on the beach or in picnic area**
- No horseplay, such as running, splashing, shoving or dunking
- **Flotation devices are prohibited except US Coast Guard approved PDF (personal flotation device) in good serviceable condition and appropriate size for intended user**
- GLASS containers are not allowed
- *Throwing harmful objects such as rocks is prohibited*
- Alcohol and other drugs are not allowed
- **No smoking allowed** - beaches are smoke free recreation areas
- Bicycles are not allowed in the beach area
- ***No open fires - no grills allowed***
